Protecting the Flambeau River at the Reclaimed Flambeau Mine Site

- The monitoring results of Flambeau River quality, aquatic life and the river bottom confirm that there has been absolutely no change in the water quality of the Flambeau River.
- The Flambeau River has been fully protected at every stage of the Flambeau Mine project - from construction through production and reclamation.
- Over the life of the mine, more than 1,000 analyses were performed on samples from the Flambeau River, both upstream and downstream from the site. Those analyses included water quality, sediments, crayfish, walleye and insects in the river.
- During operation, the Flambeau Mine's Water Treatment Plant treated over 600 million gallons of water collected at the mine site. This water, which was better than the mine's stringent permit standards, was discharged into the Flambeau River.
- Kennecott Minerals and Flambeau Mining have made a commitment to the State of Wisconsin to protect the undeveloped shoreline of the Flambeau River along the stretch of river that passes through Flambeau Mine owned property.
